Quick Start Guide to All Things FSA

In today's world we are all overwhelmed by the volumes of information coming at us through countless communication channels. We want to make your experience at The Friends School of Atlanta (FSA) as satisfying as possible, so we have created this "quick start guide" to point out where you can find the information you need to be fully engaged with your child's education and the FSA community.

We suggest you consult the following resources on an ongoing basis:

- The Parent Handbook, found on your NetClassroom account page and the
 website under publications, is organized to be user friendly and contains
 comprehensive information about the life and traditions of FSA. Whether you are
 new or returning to FSA, all families are asked to read the handbook at the
 beginning of the year.
- Always read the Late Quaking News (LQN), the email newsletter that comes out every Monday and includes upcoming dates to remember along with important news items about upcoming events, calls for volunteers and the life of the school.
- Also always, read the emailed Announcement Sheet, which is used to disseminate time-sensitive information that can't wait for the next LQN.
- Teachers communicate with the families of elementary students using a folder that goes home every night, which we call "kidmail." Kidmail is a two-way system. Teachers can send home assignments, artwork, class newsletters and other communications via the kidmail folder. Parents can send notes to teachers, signed forms, etc. back to school in the same kidmail folder.
- We direct middle school families to their personal Net Classroom pages to get information about classes and homework assignments as well as a Student Directory. Parents and students receive login information as school opens.
 Middle school students also keep a planner for their assignments, which helps them cultivate the habit of being independently responsible for their work.
- FSA's website also has in-depth information on our Quaker foundation and values, a Curriculum Guide for each grade level and calendars for school events, among other resources.

- At the end of the year, two emailed mailings, one in May and one in June, provide important information regarding elementary summer reading lists, forms needed and activities you can anticipate to be ready for the next school year.
 Please look for those mailings and fill out all requested forms, etc.
- If you are on social media, be sure to "like" Friends School of Atlanta on Facebook and follow us @FSAtl on Twitter as well as on Instagram. We post/tweet lots of photos and other news of the school via social media.
