Our Six-Week Workshops for Youth

Media Literacy and Video Production I – Lights, Camera, Action

In this workshop students will be introduced to media literacy and video production through project-based learning. The students will learn the basic procedures of creating a video as they work on their individual video project. Under the supervision of a professional producer, students will write and produce their own Autobiography Project; this video will be a priceless keepsake to share with family and friends. Class sessions will include lectures, interviews and hands-on learning activities. Students will learn how to operate video camera.

Video Production II – Moving Forward

In this workshop students will learn how to do scholarly research to obtain information and produce a short video biography about a “living legend” through project-based learning. Students will learn how to operate camera, and audio.

Video Production III – International Video Project: Building Bridges

In this workshop students will learn about different places, people and cultures. Students will work together on production teams. They will write and produce a video letters to send to a class of students in another country.
